CTE Dual Credit (known as Tech Prep nationwide) enables high school students to earn college credit in addition to their high school credit (**Dual Credit**) for articulated **Career & Technical Education (CTE)** classes. **Pacific NW College Credit** is a CTE Dual Credit Consortium and facilitates the process for dual credit to be available to students at our partner high schools and skill centers without ever leaving their home campus! Students must complete at least 1.0 credits (a full year) of CTE to meet state graduation requirements, which means ALL STUDENTS will take a CTE class at some point in their high school career. Many of these CTE classes are eligible for **CTE Dual Credit**, meaning students can earn college credit for work they are already required to do!
