How to Earn College Credit

- 1. Enroll: Sign up for eligible class(es) at your high school (view current classes)
- 2. Register: Register online at PNWcollegecredit.org/Register/
 - Register between December 1st and June 15th
- 3. Pay Fee: Pay a \$50 consortium fee online at PNWcollegecredit.org/PAY
 - ✗ Fee is non-refundable
 - Fee waivers are available for those in need
 - ➤ Due by June 20th
- 4. Achieve Grades: Earn a grade of "B" or higher in the class
- 5. Get Transcribed: Must request transcription from college
