earn both high school and college credits simultaneously!

These high school classes are aligned with college-level professional or technical courses, contributing to certificates or degree programs at the participating colleges.

What are the Benefits of CTE Dual Credit?

- **Earn College Credit:** Gain college credits while still in high school—a fantastic opportunity to get a head-start on your college education and career!
- **Career Exploration:** Explore potential careers during high school
- **Cost Savings:** Save on tuition, books, and transportation costs

How to Earn College Credit

- 1. Enroll: Sign up for eligible class(es) at your high school
- 2. Register: Register online at PNWcollegecredit.org/Register
 - Register between December 1st and June 15th
- 3. Pay Fee: Pay a \$50 consortium fee online at PNWcollegecredit.org/PAY
 - Fee is non-refundable
 - Fee waivers are available for those in need
 - Due by June 20th
- 4. Achieve Grades: Earn a grade of "B" or higher in the class
- 5. **Get Transcribed:** Must request transcription from college
 - Steps required by each college are outlined here: PNWcollegecredit.org/Transcripts
