## How Do I Register to Earn Both High School and College Credit?

- Registration is open: December 1, 2024 June 15, 2025
- Create an Account in Career & Technical Education (CTE), State Enrollment & Reporting System (SERS): CTESERS.org
- From CTE SERS home page, Choose "Students"
  - New student? Click "Create New SERS Account"
  - Returning student? Login with your username and password
- From Students home page, click "Registration"
  - Click "Register for Classes"
  - Make sure the correct high school is displayed (no need to fill in other fields)
  - Click "Search"
  - Place a checkmark in the box to the left of the class(es) you are taking
- Go to the "Review" page
  - Review registered class(es). Verify class and college, then choose teacher
  - Click "Save and Register"
- Go to the Registration Confirmation page by clicking on the printer icon in the upper right corner
  - Confirmation will be emailed to you. Save or Print the confirmation page for your records.

## You Are Almost There...

- Pay Consortium Fee by June 20, 2025
  - Pay one, non-refundable fee per school year (not per class) PNWcollegecredit.org/PAY
- Request College Transcription
  - Review SERS to ensure your classes are ready to be transcribed
    - O Class(es) must show as **completed** (grade entered and fee marked as paid)
    - O Note which college you have earned credit from
  - Follow instructions for college awarding credit: PNWcollegecredit.org/transcripts
