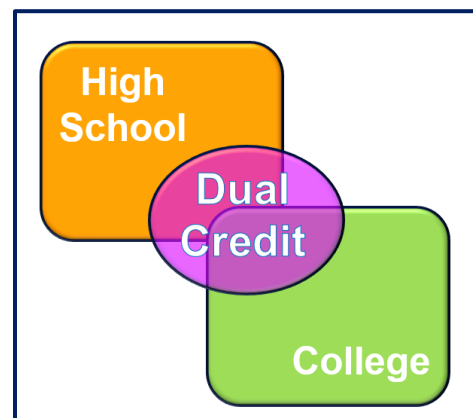


CTE Dual Credit Information Sessions
